



June 29, 2025, Scroll Burned and Re-Written Jeremiah 36:1-8, 21-23, 27-31

Use this resource at home to guide your household's daily devotions.



Pray: Light a candle and open your devotion time with a prayer.

Holy God, in scripture we have heard and continue to hear over and over your call to do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with you. Awaken us again each day to hear your voice and prioritize your call in our lives, that we might be beacons of hope in an often challenging and frightening world. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.



Read: Read the key verse from Sunday's reading.

Take another scroll and write on it all the former words that were in the first scroll, which King Jehoiakim of Judah has burned. (Jer 36:28)



Reflect: Reflect on the scripture summary.

King Jehoiakim tries to destroy the words of Jeremiah as if burning them could silence the God whose word brought all creation in existence.



Connect: Connect in conversation with others in your household.

- What was a high point of your day? What was a low point?
- When have you been resistant to what God was asking you to do or not do?
- How does it feel to know that God gives second chances?
- For the littles: Is it sometimes hard to listen to your adults?
 Why or why not?



Bless: Close your devotion with a blessing.

May God help you to heed God's good words in your life. Amen.



Do: By acting on what we learn, we make God's word come alive. Do the following activity this week.

Write a letter to an elected official about an issue that is important to you. As you write, ask God to help you find the words, and ask that the recipient read your words with an open mind and heart.
